Courses used to satisfy the general education requirements of the university must be taken from a minimum of six different academic disciplines. First Year

Art major Foundation Requirements. The following courses must be completed in the student's first year in the Art Department: ART 101, ART 102, and ART203. ART 303 must be completed in the student's second year. This applies to transfer students as well.
If Students concentrating in photography must take 4 of the 6 following courses: Art 325, Art 345, ART 346, ART 446, ART 447, and, ART 449. Since ART325, $345,346,446,447$ and 449 are only taught alternative years, it is imperative that students sign up for these courses at the time they are offered.
