GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

Competencies

- Basic College Math
Reading Comprehension

General Education Categories (34-35 credits total)

Table listing general education categories like FYS, W-I, OC, PGR, CEA, WC, HP, CS, SR, and QR with their respective credit values.

Written Communication (Level II and Level III)

Table for written communication requirements at Level II and Level III.

COURSES IN MAJOR (33 credits total)

Major Core Courses (15 credits)

Table listing major core courses such as Global Climate Change, Introduction to Geography, and Intro to Maps & GIS.

Major Concentration Courses (6 credits)

Table listing major concentration courses like Intro to Travel and Tourism and Economic Geography.

Concentration Electives (12 credits)

Choose four of these courses:

Table listing concentration elective options such as Parks and Protected Areas, Recreation Geography, and Tourism Development.

Minor/Free Electives (52 credits minimum)

May be necessary to take additional credits to attain the minimum 120 credits required for graduation depending on choices made for general education or minor selection.

Large empty grid table for entering minor/free elective course selections.

Students may choose to use support courses to satisfy general education categories, but may not be required to do so. Note: If a course is used to satisfy two or more requirements...

- Courses used to satisfy the general education requirements of the university must be taken from a minimum of six different academic disciplines.
Seminar and Level I Written Communications courses are exempt from this restriction.
These Scientific Reasoning General Education Category courses do not have to be a sequence or be from the same discipline.
Level II and Level III Written Communications Courses may be used to satisfy requirements anywhere else in a student's program of study where they may apply.
Regional Electives: GPH 220, 221, 222, 229, 233, 234, 235, 236, 237..
